

CODE OF CONDUCT and ANTI-BULLYING POLICY**Code of Conduct**

Each student and staff member has the right to attend Saint Charles School in a safe and peaceful environment. Each student will begin each quarter of the school year with a conduct grade of 100 points. Failure to act according to the belief statements below will result in points being deducted from the student's conduct grade. **These grades will be recorded on the student's report card each quarter.**

POINTS	CONSEQUENCES
100 - 86 points	Expected behavior at all times (A-B)
85 - 80 points	Detention for each violation below 86 (C)
79 -71 points	Detention/possible conference with parent/principal/teacher Behavior contract may be implemented
70 and below	In-School suspension

We assert the following belief statements about our Christian behavior while attending Saint Charles School. We will work together to help ourselves and each other achieve these goals:

I. Saint Charles School students base their actions on the example of Jesus who accepted each person as a gift. Failure to live according to this standard includes the following actions.

II. Saint Charles School students act respectfully toward others. Failure to live according to this standard includes the following actions and corresponding penalties:

Fighting	10 points
Inappropriate gestures	5 points
Disrespect of a teacher/staff member	10 points
Defiant and belligerent behavior	5 -10 points
Causing injury to another	10 points

III. Saint Charles School students accept responsibility for their actions. Failure to live according to this standard includes the following actions and corresponding penalties:

Lying	5 points
Cheating	10 points and grade adjustment
Late conduct Card	5 points
Skipping detention	5 points and another detention
Misbehavior	5 points
___ in halls	___ in restrooms
___ in church	___ on the playground
___ during safety drills	___ during assemblies
___ on field trips	___ in the locker room
___ in class	___ eating/drinking food outside the cafeteria
___ in cafeteria	___ cell phone use during school hours

IV. Saint Charles School students respect the property of others. Failure to live according to this standard includes the following actions and corresponding penalties:

Chewing gum, eating candy	5 points
Stealing	10 points *
Abuse or misuse of school and/or personal property	10 points plus restitution *

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V. Saint Charles students will be in compliance with the Saint Charles School dress code policy. Failure to live according to this standard includes the following actions and corresponding penalties:

Dress code violations	5 points
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VI. Saint Charles students will obey all rules of safe behaviors at school. Failure to live according to this standard includes the following actions and corresponding penalties:

Possession of drugs or alcohol	30 points and referral to counseling/diversion
Illegal activity	30 points and notification of law enforcement

*** School detentions will be served from 7:00 a.m. to 7:45 a.m. on the Thursday following the receipt of the conduct notice.*

Each teacher sets his/her own classroom rules. Infractions of these specific rules will be handled individually between each teacher and student/parent. (e.g. homework, not having materials/books, etc.)
